Notes:

- If a student requires a break this year, they will need to so in the calming corners
 - Materials can for breaks can include but are not limited to PlayDoh, Stress Balls, fidget toys, etc.
- Transition tools/signals used by teacher choice
- 2 reteach/check-in days after each break
 - Extended morning meetings for these two days
